NOTE: On June 10, 2008, the State Land Board asserted a state claim to the bed and banks of the **Rogue River** below the line of ordinary high water from RM 68 to 158. Litigation has been filed concerning this action.

NOTE: On June 21, 2002, Marion County Circuit Court Judge Paul Lipscomb declared two portions of the **John Day River** to be navigable for title purposes (from about RM 17.5 to 22.5 and RM 134.5 to 135.5). Judge Lipscomb also ordered the State Land Board to determine if a study should be undertaken as requested by the NW Steelheaders. On June 14, 2005, the Oregon State Land Board asserted a state claim to the bed and banks of the **John Day River** from RM 10 to 184.

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NOTE: As a result of tidality, the State of Oregon owns the submerged and submersible land below the line of Mean High Tide on the **Trask River** from RM 0 to 4.3.

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NOTE: As a result of tidality, the State of Oregon owns the submerged and submersible land below the line of Mean High Tide on the Kilchis River from its mouth to RM 2.0.
